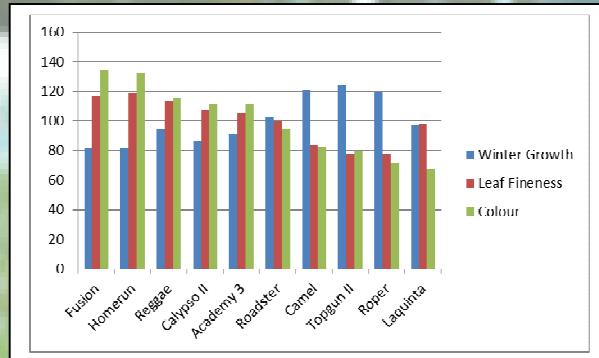


# REGGAE

## Turf Fine Leaf Ryegrass

- ✓ Dark green with fine leaves.
- ✓ Low leaf shredding
- ✓ Good disease resistance
- ✓ Excellent sward density
- ✓ Ideal for over seeding



Valley Seeds' plant breeders have made a successful reselection from Calypso II, selecting for colour, heat tolerance and density.

**REGGAE** fine leaf ryegrass is the result of this work and is available this season.

**REGGAE** fine leaf ryegrass will provide excellent dark green colour during winter and spring. Reggae is ideal for overseeding warm season sports playing surfaces such as couch and kikuyu.

**REGGAE** fine leaf ryegrass will establish quickly at the recommended sowing rate (see below) and provide quick cover over warm season grasses as they go dormant over winter.

**REGGAE** fine leaf ryegrass has shown a low incidence of leaf shredding, important for high profile Rugby League, Rugby Union and Australian rules stadiums and playing fields.

**REGGAE** fine leaf ryegrass has good disease resistance compared to most common sports grass experienced by professional turf curators.

**REGGAE** fine leaf ryegrass demonstrates good sward density due to its high leaf to stem ratio. This provides good wear resistance during winter/spring.

The sowing rate for Reggae fine leaf ryegrass:

	New sowings	Oversowing
<b>REGGAE</b> fine leaf ryegrass	4kg to 5kg per 100m <sup>2</sup> 400kg to 500kg per hectare	3kg to 4kg per 100m <sup>2</sup> 300kg to 400kg per hectare
